## Actions you can take to support local Native Americans and environmental justice

1. Standing Rock Dakota Access Pipeline (DAPL) litigation
  - a. On Sept 23, 2020 24 Members of Congress supported the tribes in the most recent filing by their attorneys. Ask Idaho Members of Congress to join their colleagues in upholding Environmental Protection regulations to protect tribal people and lands.
