Because Unitarian Universalists affirm respect for the interdependent web of all existence of which we are a part,

Now, therefore, be it hereby RESOLVED that the Boise Unitarian Universalist Fellowship takes the following position:

As Idahoans and members of the Boise Unitarian Universalist Fellowship who are increasingly concerned about wildfire, water supply, extreme weather, and other health and national security impacts of measurable annual increases in global temperatures on ourselves and future generations, we ask our representatives in the Idaho Legislature and in Congress to:

1. Publicly acknowledge that greenhouse gas emissions must be reduced;
2. Sponsor or co-sponsor legislation to reduce U.S. and global emissions to levels which a consensus of global scientists and political leaders meeting periodically deem safe and sustainable.

Be it further RESOLVED that the Boise Unitarian Universalist Fellowship commits to the following action steps to be a prominent and faithful voice of witness, advocacy, education, and protest, if necessary, in the public sphere:

Supporting community partners and coalitions working to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
